The full-beam master suite occupies a prime position on the lower deck, offering exceptional privacy and comfort. It features a king-size berth, generous storage, a dedicated seating area, and a spacious en-suite bathroom. Large hull windows provide abundant natural light and panoramic views, enhancing the sense of space and connection to the sea.

Guests

Three additional guest cabins complete the accommodations: two oversized doubles and one twin, each with private en-suite facilities. The design emphasizes both comfort and functionality, with ample wardrobe space, refined finishes, and discreet lighting. All guest cabins are located on the lower deck, ensuring a quiet and restful environment.

Crew

Dedicated quarters for four crew members are arranged for efficiency and privacy. The captain's cabin, aft to port, includes a double berth, while two forward cabins each offer a single berth. Crew spaces are supported by functional amenities, enabling professional service without intruding on guest areas.
